AN ACT relating to elections; revising the definition of a committee for political action; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. NRS 294A.0055 is hereby amended to read as follows: 294A.0055 "Committee for political action" means [an organization which receives contributions, makes] any organization that:

- 1. Receives contributions totaling more than \$1,000 in a calendar year;
- 2. Makes contributions to candidates or other persons totaling more than \$1,000 in a calendar year; or [makes]
- 3. Makes expenditures totaling more than \$1,000 in a calendar year,
- which are designed to affect the outcome of any primary, general or special election or question on the ballot. The term does not include a committee for the recall of a public officer.
