AN ACT relating to the legislature; providing for an annual adjustment of the compensation
for a legislator based on the consumer price index; and providing other matters
properly relating thereto.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN
SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- 1 **Section 1.** NRS 218.210 is hereby amended to read as follows:

- 3 *1. Except as otherwise provided in subsection 3, each* senator and
- 4 assemblyman is entitled to receive as compensation ~~\$130~~ *the amount set*
- 5 *forth in subsection 2* per day for each day of service:
- 6 ~~1-1~~ *(a)* During any regular session, for the number of days the
- 7 legislature is in session, or in adjournment for not more than 3 days, or the
- 8 maximum number of days for which compensation for a regular session is
- 9 permitted by the constitution, whichever is smaller; and
- 10 ~~2-1~~ *(b)* During any special session, for the number of days the
- 11 legislature is in session or the maximum number of days for which
- 12 compensation for a special session is permitted by the constitution,
- 13 whichever is smaller.
- 14 *2. The amount each senator and assemblyman is entitled to receive*
- 15 *per day pursuant to subsection 1 is \$130, cumulatively increased on July*
- 16 *1 of each year in an amount corresponding to the percentage of increase*
- 17 *in the Consumer Price Index (All Items) published by the United States*
- 18 *Department of Labor for the preceding fiscal year. The amount of*
- 19 *compensation per day pursuant to this subsection must not decrease.*
