AN ACT making supplemental appropriations to the Department of Motor Vehicles and Public Safety for shortfalls in the Division of Parole and Probation and Central Services, Management Services and Field Services; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. There is hereby appropriated from the state highway fund to the Department of Motor Vehicles and Public Safety the sum of \$60,851 for an unanticipated shortfall in the money budgeted for Management Services. This appropriation is supplemental to that made by section 29 of chapter 571, Statutes of Nevada 1999, at page 2985.

Sec. 2. There is hereby appropriated from the state general fund to the Department of Motor Vehicles and Public Safety the sum of \$2,493 for an unanticipated stale payroll claim of the Division of Parole and Probation. This appropriation is supplemental to that made by section 27 of chapter 571 of Statutes of Nevada 1999, at page 2984.

Sec. 3. There is hereby appropriated from the state highway fund to the Department of Motor Vehicles and Public Safety the sum of \$1,805,420 for an unanticipated shortfall in the money budgeted for new positions in Field Services. This appropriation is supplemental to that made by section 29 of chapter 571 of Statutes of Nevada 1999, at page 2984.

Sec. 4. There is hereby appropriated from the state highway fund to the Department of Motor Vehicles and Public Safety the sum of \$230,472 for an unanticipated shortfall in the money budgeted for new positions in



- Central Services. This appropriation is supplemental to that made by section 29 of chapter 571 of Statutes of Nevada 1999, at page 2985.

 Sec. 5. This act becomes effective upon passage and approval.
