SUMMARY-Revises requirements for licenses for certain instructors for schools for training drivers. (BDR 43-1173)

AN ACT relating to motor vehicles; requiring an instructor for a school for training drivers who provides instruction solely to applicants for commercial drivers' licenses to have a high school diploma or its equivalent or to complete certain experience; providing that such an instructor is not required to complete requirements for continuing education; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

**Section 1.** NRS 483.720 is hereby amended to read as follows: 483.720 1. An applicant for a license as an instructor for a school for training drivers must:

(a) Be of good moral character;

(b) Pass such examination as the department may require on traffic laws, safe driving practices and *the* operation of motor vehicles;

[3.] (c) Be physically able to operate a motor vehicle safely and train others in the operation of motor vehicles;

[4.] (d) Hold a valid Nevada driver's license;

[5.] (e) Be 21 years of age or older; and

(f) Hold a valid driving instructor's certificate issued by the state department of education in accordance with regulations prescribed by the state board of education governing the qualifications of instructors in privately owned schools for training drivers.

2. In addition to the requirements set forth in subsection 1, an instructor who provides instruction solely to applicants for commercial drivers' licenses must have:

(a) A high school diploma or its equivalent; or

(b) At least 5 years of experience in operating a commercial motor vehicle.



- **Sec. 2.** NRS 483.730 is hereby amended to read as follows:
- 483.730 1. The department shall issue a license to operate a school for training drivers or to act as an instructor for such a school, if it is satisfied that the applicant has met the qualifications required by NRS 483.700 to 483.780, inclusive.
- The license is valid for 5 years after the date of issuance, unless canceled, suspended or revoked by the department and, except as otherwise provided in subsection 3, may be renewed subject to the same conditions as the original license.
- 3. The Except as otherwise provided in subsection 5, the department may renew the license of an instructor of a school for training drivers if, when he submits his application for the renewal of his license, he provides evidence satisfactory to the department that, during the period of the license, he completed at least six credits of continuing education by attending:
- (a) A course of instruction relating to the training of drivers approved by the department; or
- (b) A state or national conference approved by the department of education for credit for continuing education.
- 4. In determining whether an instructor has complied with the provisions of subsection 3, the department shall award one credit of continuing education for the completion of each 15 hours of:
- (a) Classroom instruction in a course specified in paragraph (a) of subsection 3; or
- (b) Attendance at a conference specified in paragraph (b) of subsection 3.
- 5. The provisions of subsection 3 do not apply to an instructor who provides instruction solely to applicants for commercial drivers' licenses.Sec. 3. This act becomes effective:

- 30 1. Upon passage and approval for the purpose of revising regulations by the department of motor vehicles and public safety to comply with the 31 provisions of this act; and 32
  - 2. On July 1, 2001, for all other purposes.
