AN ACT relating to insurance; authorizing certain insurers to offer policies of insurance that cover employees for both work-related and nonwork-related illnesses and injuries; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Chapter 690B is hereby amended by adding thereto a new section to read as follows:

1. A casualty insurer who is also authorized pursuant to chapter 680A of NRS to transact health insurance may offer a product of insurance to employers that, under a single policy, covers the injuries and illnesses of employees, regardless of whether those injuries and illnesses are work-related or arise under circumstances traditionally addressed by health insurance.

2. A product of insurance described in subsection 1, must allow employees covered by the product to:

(a) Choose their providers of health care freely and not be restricted to choosing those providers of health care from an approved list; or

(b) Be served by a single network of providers of health care that is the same regardless of whether the employee's illness or injury is workrelated or arises under circumstances traditionally addressed by health insurance.

3. The provisions of this section do not abrogate or decrease the effect of any of the provisions of chapters 616A to 616D, inclusive, or chapter 617 of NRS.
