THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. There is hereby appropriated from the state general fund to the Alzheimer's Association - Southern Nevada Chapter for expenses relating to the provision of temporary respite care and for training in and operation of the Safe Return Program, a nationwide program that assists in the identification and safe, timely return of persons with Alzheimer's disease and related dementias: For the fiscal year 2001-2002......\$171,000

either fiscal year. Any balance of those sums must not be committed for expenditure after June 30, 2003, and reverts to the state general fund as soon as all payments of money committed have been made.
