AN ACT making an appropriation for the support of a historical book to be published by the Women's Research Institute of Nevada of the University of Nevada, Las Vegas; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

**Section 1.** There is hereby appropriated from the state general fund to the Women's Research Institute of Nevada of the University of Nevada, Las Vegas, the sum of \$50,000 for expenses related to the writing and publication of a book chronicling the contributions women have made throughout the history of Nevada.

**Sec. 2.** Any remaining balance of the appropriation made by section 1 of this act must not be committed for expenditure after June 30, 2003, and reverts to the state general fund as soon as all payments of money committed have been made.



1 **Sec. 3.** This act becomes effective upon passage and approval.
