AN ACT making an appropriation to White Pine County for the preparation of a plan for the development and management of tourism assets within the proposed Great Basin National Heritage Area; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

**Section 1.** There is hereby appropriated from the state general fund to White Pine County the sum of \$75,000 to be disbursed to the Great Basin Heritage Area Partnership for the preparation of a plan for the development and management of tourism assets within the proposed Great Basin National Heritage Area.

**Sec. 2.** Any remaining balance of the appropriation made by section 1 of this act must not be committed for expenditure after June 30, 2003, and reverts to the state general fund as soon as all payments of money committed have been made.

**Sec. 3.** This act becomes effective upon passage and approval.
