AN ACT making an appropriation to White Pine County for the preparation of a plan for the development and management of tourism assets within the proposed Great Basin National Heritage Area; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN
SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- 1 **Section 1.** There is hereby appropriated from the state general fund to
- 2 White Pine County the sum of \$75,000 to be disbursed to the Great Basin
- 3 Heritage Area Partnership for the preparation of a plan for the development
- 4 and management of tourism assets within the proposed Great Basin
- 5 National Heritage Area.
- 6 **Sec. 2.** Any remaining balance of the appropriation made by section 1
- 7 of this act must not be committed for expenditure after June 30, 2003, and
- 8 reverts to the state general fund as soon as all payments of money
- 9 committed have been made.
- 10 **Sec. 3.** This act becomes effective upon passage and approval.
