SUMMARY—Revises provisions relating to settlement of certain claims or actions against governmental entities and officers and employees thereof. (BDR 3-378)

AN ACT relating to tort actions; prohibiting the inclusion of any provision in an agreement to settle a tort claim or action against a governmental entity or an officer or employee thereof that makes the agreement confidential; providing that an agreement to settle such a tort claim or action is a public record; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

# THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

**Section 1.** Chapter 41 of NRS is hereby amended by adding thereto a new section to read as follows:

1. Any agreement to settle a claim or action brought under NRS 41.031 or against a present or former officer or employee of the state or any political subdivision, immune contractor or state legislator:

(a) Must not provide that any or all of the terms of the agreement are confidential.

(b) Is a public record and must be open for inspection pursuant to NRS 239.010.

2. Any provision of an agreement to settle a claim or action brought under NRS 41.031 or against a present or former officer or employee of the state or any political subdivision, immune contractor or state legislator that conflicts with this section is void.

**Sec. 2.** NRS 41.0305 is hereby amended to read as follows:

41.0305 As used in NRS 41.0305 to 41.039, inclusive, and section 1 of this act, the term "political subdivision" includes an organization that was officially designated as a community action agency pursuant to 42 U.S.C. § 2790 before that section was repealed and is included in the definition of an "eligible entity" pursuant to 42 U.S.C. § 9902, the Nevada



- rural housing authority, an airport authority created by special act of the legislature, a regional transportation commission and a fire protection district, irrigation district, school district, governing body of a charter school and other special district that performs a governmental function, even though it does not exercise general governmental powers.
