AN ACT relating to veterans; making appropriations for the establishment of the national memorial for World War II veterans and for the preservation and maintenance of the Nevada Veterans Center and Museum; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- **Section 1.** 1. There is hereby appropriated from the state general fund to the World War II Memorial Campaign the sum of \$100,000 for the establishment of the national memorial for World War II veterans.
- 2. There is hereby appropriated from the state general fund to the Council of Nevada Veterans Organizations the sum of \$50,000 for the installation and maintenance of an elevator, for other necessary equipment and for the maintenance and preservation of the Nevada Veterans Center and Museum.



- Sec. 2. Any remaining balance of the appropriations made by section 1 of this act must not be committed for expenditure after June 30, 2003, and reverts to the state general fund as soon as all payments of money committed have been made.
