ASSEMBLY BILL NO. 27—ASSEMBLYMAN PERKINS

SUMMARY—Prohibits entity that supervises juvenile who is ordered to perform work or community service from placing juvenile on highway except under certain circumstances or other dangerous situation. (BDR 5-671)

AN ACT relating to juveniles; prohibiting an entity that supervises a juvenile who is ordered to perform work or community service from placing the juvenile on a highway except under certain circumstances or in any other dangerous situation; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN  
SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- 1     **Section 1.** Chapter 62 of NRS is hereby amended by adding thereto a  
2     new section to read as follows:  
3     1. *Except as otherwise provided in subsections 2 and 3, if a child is*  
4     *required to perform any work or community service pursuant to this*  
5     *chapter, the supervising entity shall not allow the child to perform the*  
6     *work or community service on or near a highway or in any other*  
7     *dangerous situation.*  
8     2. *A supervising entity may allow children to perform work or*  
9     *community service on or near a controlled-access highway if:*  
10    (a) *The children are not required to perform any work or service in*  
11    *the median of the highway;*  
12    (b) *The work or service is performed behind a guardrail or other*  
13    *safety barrier;*  
14    (c) *Appropriate warning signs are placed on the highway at least 100*  
15    *yards in front of the location where the children are working from both*  
16    *directions, as appropriate based on the speed of the vehicles traveling on*  
17    *the highway;*  
18    (d) *A vehicle with an amber light placed on top of the vehicle is placed*  
19    *at the site in a manner which shields the children from traffic;*  
20    (e) *The children are required to wear reflective vests and orange hats;*



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- 1     (f) The supervising entity obtains written permission from the parents  
2     or guardians of the children; and  
3     (g) The supervising entity obtains written permission from and  
4     complies with all safety rules of the governmental entity with authority  
5     over the controlled-access highway.  
6     3. A supervising entity may allow children to perform work or  
7     community service on or near a highway that does not have controlled  
8     access if:  
9     (a) The children are not required to perform any work or service in  
10    the median of the highway;  
11    (b) Appropriate warning signs are placed at least 100 yards in front of  
12    the location where the children are working from both directions, as  
13    appropriate based on the speed of the vehicles traveling on the highway;  
14    (c) A vehicle with an amber light placed on top of the vehicle is placed  
15    at the site in a manner which shields the children from traffic;  
16    (d) The children are required to wear reflective vests and orange hats;  
17    (e) The supervising entity obtains written permission from the parents  
18    or guardians of the children; and  
19    (f) The supervising entity obtains written permission from and  
20    complies with all safety rules of the governmental entity with authority  
21    over the highway.  
22    4. Upon the request of the parent or guardian of a child who is  
23    assigned to perform work or community service on or near a highway  
24    pursuant to subsection 2 or 3, the supervising entity shall make available  
25    to the parent or guardian of the child information regarding the nature  
26    of the work or community service to be performed by the child and the  
27    specific location at which the work or community service is to be  
28    performed.  
29    5. As used in this section:  
30    (a) "Community service" includes, without limitation, public service,  
31    work on public projects, supervised work for the benefit of the  
32    community or any other work required by the court.  
33    (b) "Controlled-access highway" has the meaning ascribed to it in  
34    NRS 484.041.  
35    (c) "Highway" means a street, road or thoroughfare of any kind used  
36    by the public.  
37    (d) "Other dangerous situation" means any situation that poses a  
38    reasonably foreseeable risk that serious bodily harm or injury to a child  
39    could occur.  
40    (e) "Supervising entity" means a person or entity who is responsible  
41    for supervising children who are ordered to perform work or community  
42    service pursuant to this chapter.  
43    Sec. 2. This act becomes effective upon passage and approval.
