AN ACT making appropriations to the Newlands Project Water Rights Fund and Truckee-Carson Irrigation District for certain expenses relating to water rights; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN  
SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- 1     **Section 1.** 1. There is hereby appropriated from the state general  
2 fund to the Newlands Project Water Rights Fund created by section 5 of  
3 chapter 515, Statutes of Nevada 1999, at page 2633:  
4         For the fiscal year 2001-2002..... \$105,940  
5         For the fiscal year 2002-2003..... \$105,940  
6     2. The sums appropriated by subsection 1 are available for either fiscal  
7 year. Any balance of those sums must not be committed for expenditure  
8 after June 30, 2003, and reverts to the state general fund as soon as all  
9 payments of money committed have been made.
- 10    **Sec. 2.** 1. There is hereby appropriated from the state general fund  
11 to the Truckee-Carson Irrigation District for operating and maintenance  
12 costs related to the sale of water rights for the Newlands Project:  
13         For the fiscal year 2001-2002..... \$325,000  
14         For the fiscal year 2002-2003..... \$325,000  
15     2. The sums appropriated by subsection 1 are available for either fiscal  
16 year. Any balance of those sums must not be committed for expenditure  
17 after June 30, 2003, and reverts to the state general fund as soon as all  
18 payments of money committed have been made.



1     **Sec. 3.**   This act becomes effective upon passage and approval.
