AN ACT making an appropriation to the Department of Museums, Library and Arts for the support of the Nevada Ballet Theatre, Inc., for its cultural and educational outreach program for schools, dance students and theater audiences; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. There is hereby appropriated from the state general fund to the Department of Museums, Library and Arts the sum of \$100,000 for the support of the Nevada Ballet Theatre, Inc., for touring this state to conduct its cultural and educational outreach program for schools, dance students and theater audiences.

Sec. 2. Any remaining balance of the appropriation made by section 1 of this act must not be committed for expenditure after June 30, 2003, and reverts to the state general fund as soon as all payments of money committed have been made.
