AN ACT relating to low-income housing; requiring the allocation of money from the account for low-income housing for a model demonstration project to provide an assisted living center for senior citizens in Clark County; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN
 SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- 1 **Section 1.** The Administrator of the Housing Division of the
- 2 Department of Business and Industry shall allocate and reserve from the
- 3 account for low-income housing created by NRS 319.500 the sum of
- 4 \$450,000 for fiscal year 2001-2002 and the sum of \$450,000 for fiscal year
- 5 2002-2003 for a model demonstration project sponsored by a nonprofit
- 6 corporation to provide an assisted living center for senior citizens living in
- 7 Clark County.
- 8 **Sec. 2.** This act becomes effective upon passage and approval.
