AN ACT making an appropriation to the Department of Administration for the support of amateur athletics and recreational programs in the City of Las Vegas; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. 1. There is hereby appropriated from the state general fund to the Department of Administration the sum of \$100,000 for allocation to the City of Las Vegas.

2. The money appropriated by subsection 1 must be allocated by the City of Las Vegas to the "Hen Hen Dog Catchers" to support amateur athletics and recreational programs in the City of Las Vegas.

- 3. Any remaining balance of the appropriation made by subsection 1 must not be committed for expenditure after June 30, 2003, and reverts to the state general fund as soon as all payments of money committed have been made.
 - 4. The City of Las Vegas shall:

- (a) Establish and maintain records concerning the use of the money appropriated by subsection 1 which conform to generally accepted accounting practices; and
- (b) Provide a written report to the director of the Legislative Counsel Bureau for transmission to the Legislative Commission on or before January 1, 2003, which clearly describes the expenditures made from the money appropriated by subsection 1 and their benefit to the state.
 - Sec. 2. This act becomes effective upon passage and approval.
