AN ACT making an appropriation to the Department of Administration for the support of amateur athletics and recreational programs in the City of Las Vegas; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN  
SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- 1 **Section 1.** 1. There is hereby appropriated from the state general
- 2 fund to the Department of Administration the sum of \$100,000 for
- 3 allocation to the City of Las Vegas.
- 4 2. The money appropriated by subsection 1 must be allocated by the
- 5 City of Las Vegas to the “Hen Hen Dog Catchers” to support amateur
- 6 athletics and recreational programs in the City of Las Vegas.
- 7 3. Any remaining balance of the appropriation made by subsection 1
- 8 must not be committed for expenditure after June 30, 2003, and reverts to
- 9 the state general fund as soon as all payments of money committed have
- 10 been made.
- 11 4. The City of Las Vegas shall:
- 12 (a) Establish and maintain records concerning the use of the money
- 13 appropriated by subsection 1 which conform to generally accepted
- 14 accounting practices; and
- 15 (b) Provide a written report to the director of the Legislative Counsel
- 16 Bureau for transmission to the Legislative Commission on or before
- 17 January 1, 2003, which clearly describes the expenditures made from the
- 18 money appropriated by subsection 1 and their benefit to the state.
- 19 **Sec. 2.** This act becomes effective upon passage and approval.
