AN ACT making an appropriation to the Department of Human Resources for an increase in the allowance for personal needs for residents of long-term care facilities who are eligible for Medicaid; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. There is hereby appropriated from the state general fund to the Department of Human Resources the sum of \$633,120 for an increase in the allowance for personal needs for residents of long-term care facilities who are eligible for Medicaid.

Sec. 2. Any remaining balance of the appropriation made by section 1 of this act must not be committed for expenditure after June 30, 2003, and reverts to the state general fund as soon as all payments of money committed have been made.

Sec. 3. This act becomes effective on July 1, 2001.
