## ASSEMBLY BILL NO. 403—ASSEMBLYMEN NEIGHBORS AND TIFFANY

MARCH 16, 2001

Referred to Concurrent Committees on Natural Resources,  
Agriculture, and Mining and Ways and Means

SUMMARY—Makes appropriation to State Department of Conservation and Natural Resources for costs relating to preservation of Walker Lake. (BDR S-802)

AN ACT making an appropriation to the State Department of Conservation and Natural Resources for costs relating to the preservation of Walker Lake; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN  
SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- 1     **Section 1.** There is hereby appropriated from the state general fund to  
2     the State Department of Conservation and Natural Resources, Office of the  
3     Director, for planning, cleaning up the river channel and buying upstream  
4     water rights related to the preservation of Walker Lake:  
5         For fiscal year 2001-2002..... \$275,000  
6         For fiscal year 2002-2003..... \$375,000
- 7     **Sec. 2.** 1. The Office of the Director of the State Department of  
8     Conservation and Natural Resources may use the money appropriated by  
9     section 1 of this act for fiscal year 2001-2002 only if \$100,000 in matching  
10    money is provided by the United States Army Corps of Engineers.  
11    2. The State Controller shall not transfer the sum appropriated by  
12    section 1 of this act for fiscal year 2001-2002 until the Office of the  
13    Director of the State Department of Conservation and Natural Resources  
14    has provided proof satisfactory to the State Controller that the United  
15    States Army Corps of Engineers has contributed \$100,000 for this project.
- 16    **Sec. 3.** The sums appropriated by section 1 of this act are available for  
17    either fiscal year. Any balance of those sums must not be committed for  
18    expenditure after June 30, 2005, and reverts to the state general fund as  
19    soon as all payments of money committed have been made.



1     **Sec. 4.** This act becomes effective upon passage and approval.
