### THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

**Section 1.** NRS 371.040 is hereby amended to read as follows:

371.040 The annual amount of the basic privilege tax throughout the state is [4] 3 cents on each \$1 of valuation of the vehicle as determined by the department.

**Sec. 2.** NRS 371.040 is hereby amended to read as follows: 371.040 The annual amount of the basic privilege tax throughout the state is [3] 2 cents on each \$1 of valuation of the vehicle as determined by the department.

**Sec. 3.** NRS 371.040 is hereby amended to read as follows:

371.040 The annual amount of the basic privilege tax throughout the state is [2 cents] 1 cent on each \$1 of valuation of the vehicle as determined by the department.
