AN ACT relating to the University and Community College System of Nevada; establishing the duty of board of regents of the University of Nevada to appoint certain administrative personnel; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. NRS 396.210 is hereby amended to read as follows:

396.210 1. After consultation with the faculty, the board of regents shall appoint a chancellor of the system [1], a president of each university, a president for each campus of each community college that has an enrollment of more than 20,000 students and a president for each of the other community colleges.

2. The chancellor **[shall]** and presidents must each have a degree from a college or university recognized as equal in rank to those having membership in the Association of American Universities.

Sec. 2. NRS 396.220 is hereby amended to read as follows:

396.220 The board of regents shall fix the salary of the chancellor of the system [-] and of the presidents of the universities, community colleges and, if applicable, campuses of a community college.

Sec. 3. This act becomes effective on July 1, 2001.
