AN ACT making an appropriation from the state highway fund to the Department of Motor Vehicles and Public Safety for the creation and maintenance of a branch office in Boulder City; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN
SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 **Section 1.** There is hereby appropriated from the state highway fund
2 to the Department of Motor Vehicles and Public Safety for the creation and
3 maintenance of a branch office of the Department in Boulder City:

4 For the fiscal year 2001-2002.....\$135,000

5 For the fiscal year 2002-2003.....\$135,000

6 **Sec. 2.** Any balance of the sums appropriated by section 1 of this act
7 remaining at the end of the respective fiscal years must not be committed
8 for expenditure after June 30 and reverts to the state highway fund as soon
9 as all payments of money committed have been made.

10 **Sec. 3.** This act becomes effective upon passage and approval.
