AN ACT making appropriations from the state general fund and the state highway fund to the Department of Motor Vehicles and Public Safety for various information technology upgrades; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN
SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- 1 **Section 1.** 1. There is hereby appropriated from the state general
- 2 fund to the Department of Motor Vehicles and Public Safety the sum of
- 3 \$442,019 to fund a share of the cost of the National Crime Information
- 4 Center's 2000 upgrade, Windows 2000 and the public safety database.
- 5 2. Any remaining balance of the appropriation made by subsection 1
- 6 must not be committed for expenditure after June 30, 2003, and reverts to
- 7 the state general fund as soon as all payments of money committed have
- 8 been made.
- 9 **Sec. 2.** 1. There is hereby appropriated from the state highway fund
- 10 to the Department of Motor Vehicles and Public Safety the sum of
- 11 \$562,569 to fund a share of the cost of the National Crime Information
- 12 Center's 2000 upgrade, Windows 2000 and the public safety database.
- 13 2. Any remaining balance of the appropriation made by subsection 1
- 14 must not be committed for expenditure after June 30, 2003, and reverts to
- 15 the state highway fund as soon as all payments of money committed have
- 16 been made.
- 17 **Sec. 3.** This act becomes effective upon passage and approval.
