AN ACT making an appropriation to the Culinary and Hospitality Academy of Las Vegas for the design and construction of a facility for vocational training in Southern Nevada; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. There is hereby appropriated from the state general fund to the Culinary and Hospitality Academy of Las Vegas the sum of \$8,000,000 for the design and construction of a facility for vocational training in Southern Nevada.
- Sec. 2. Any remaining balance of the appropriation made by section 1 of this act must not be committed for expenditure after June 30, 2005, and reverts to the state general fund as soon as all payments of money committed have been made.
- Sec. 3. This act becomes effective upon passage and approval.
