AN ACT making an appropriation to the Comstock Cemetery Foundation, Inc., for expenses relating to the historic preservation and restoration of the cemeteries located in the Virginia City area; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. There is hereby appropriated from the state general fund to the Comstock Cemetery Foundation, Inc., the sum of \$250,000 for expenses relating to the historic preservation and restoration of the cemeteries located in the Virginia City area.

Sec. 2. Any remaining balance of the appropriation made by section 1 of this act must not be committed for expenditure after June 30, 2003, and reverts to the state general fund as soon as all payments of money committed have been made.

Sec. 3. This act becomes effective upon passage and approval.
