AN ACT relating to education; requiring transfers of money from the fund for school improvement to provide scholarships for students pursuing degrees in teaching; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Section 11 of chapter 543, Statutes of Nevada 1999, at 2 page 2841, is hereby amended to read as follows: Sec. 11. 1. The superintendent of public instruction shall 3 4 transfer from the fund for school improvement to the University and 5 Community College System of Nevada [the sum of \$130,680 to be used to provide not more than 45 scholarships at the University of 6 Nevada, Las Vegas, and not more than 45 scholarships at the 7 8 9 10 For the fiscal year 2000-2001\$130,680 11 The money transferred pursuant to subsection 1 must be used each fiscal year to provide: 12 (a) Not more than 45 scholarships at the University of Nevada, 13 14 Las Vegas; and 15 (b) Not more than 45 scholarships at the University of Nevada, 16 Reno, 17 for qualified students pursuing degrees in teaching. 18 Any remaining



3. Any balance of the [sum] sums authorized for expenditure by
subsection 1 remaining at the end of the respective fiscal years must
not be committed for expenditure after June 30 [, 2001,] of the
respective fiscal years and reverts to the fund for school improvement
as soon as all payments of money committed have been made.

Sec. 2. 1. The superintendent of public instruction shall transfer from the fund for school improvement to the University and Community College System of Nevada to provide certain scholarships:

- 2. The money transferred pursuant to subsection 1 must be used each fiscal year to provide:
 (a) Not more than 45 scholarships at the University of Nevada, Las
 - (a) Not more than 45 scholarships at the University of Nevada, Las Vegas;
 - (b) Not more than 45 scholarships at the University of Nevada, Reno;
 - (c) Not more than 45 scholarships at the Nevada State College, Henderson; and
 - (d) Not more than 45 scholarships at the Great Basin College, for qualified students pursuing degrees in teaching.
 - 3. Any balance of the sums authorized for expenditure by subsection 1 remaining at the end of the respective fiscal years must not be committed for expenditure after June 30 of the respective fiscal years and reverts to the fund for school improvement as soon as all payments of money committed have been made.
- Sec. 3. 1. This section and section 1 of this act become effective upon passage and approval.
 - 2. Section 2 of this act becomes effective on July 1, 2001.
