AN ACT relating to the department of motor vehicles and public safety; requiring the department to offer to provide assistance to certain persons in complying with the Military Selective Service Act under certain circumstances; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

# THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

**Section 1.** Chapter 483 of NRS is hereby amended by adding thereto a new section to read as follows:

The department shall, in cooperation with the Selective Service System, offer to provide assistance in complying with the provisions of the Military Selective Service Act, 50 U.S.C. App. §§ 451 et seq., to each person who, at the time he applies for the issuance or renewal of a driver's license or identification card pursuant to NRS 483.010 to 483.630, inclusive, or a commercial driver's license pursuant to NRS 483.900 to 483.940, inclusive, is eligible for registration pursuant to the provisions of that Act.

Sec. 2. NRS 483.015 is hereby amended to read as follows:
483.015 Except as otherwise provided in NRS 483.330, *and section 1* 12 of this act, the provisions of NRS 483.010 to 483.630, inclusive, and 13 14 section 1 of this act, apply only with respect to noncommercial drivers'
