SUMMARY—Requires adoption of state cancer plan and mandates administrative action necessary to provide Medicaid coverage to certain patients with breast or cervical cancer. (BDR 40-277)

AN ACT relating to cancer; requiring the adoption of a state cancer plan; mandating the administrative action necessary to provide Medicaid coverage to certain patients with breast or cervical cancer; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Chapter 457 of NRS is hereby amended by adding thereto a new section to read as follows:

- 1. The health division, in consultation with the state board of health,
- (a) In cooperation with public and private entities involved in the detection, prevention and treatment of cancer and the rehabilitation of victims of cancer:
- (1) Develop a state cancer plan and revise the plan at least once every 5 years; and
- (2) Facilitate the formation and activities of a committee to monitor the implementation of the components of the state cancer plan; and
- 12 (b) Publish and submit to the legislative commission a copy of the 13 state cancer plan and each revision of the plan. 14
 - 2. The state cancer plan must:
 - (a) Include a demographic assessment of the occurrences of cancer in this state;
 - (b) Establish statewide:

- (1) Goals and objectives for the detection, prevention and treatment of cancer and the rehabilitation of victims of cancer; and
- (2) Priorities for the allocation of resources for the detection, prevention and treatment of cancer and the rehabilitation of victims of cancer;
- (c) Identify and assist in the procurement from the Federal Government and other sources any available grants and other funding for the detection, prevention and treatment of cancer and the rehabilitation of victims of cancer;
- (d) Identify and evaluate existing public and private activities, programs and resources for the detection, prevention and treatment of cancer and the rehabilitation of victims of cancer;
- (e) Promote coalitions and partnerships to achieve the goals and objectives set forth in the plan;
- (f) Develop and promote strategies and procedures to reduce any duplication of efforts among public and private programs for the detection, prevention and treatment of cancer and the rehabilitation of victims of cancer;
 - (g) Promote the coordination of activities for:
 - (1) The dissemination of information related to cancer;
 - (2) The provision of educational programs related to cancer; and
- (3) The detection, prevention and treatment of cancer and the rehabilitation of victims of cancer; and
- (h) Consist of any other component deemed suitable and appropriate by the health division.
- Sec. 2. The health division of the department of human resources shall, not later than February 1, 2003, publish the state cancer plan required pursuant to section 1 of this act and submit it to the director of the legislative counsel bureau for transmittal to the 72nd session of the Nevada legislature.
- Sec. 3. 1. The director of the department of human resources shall take such action as is necessary to include, effective July 1, 2002, in the state plan for Medicaid the coverage authorized by section 2 of the federal Breast and Cervical Cancer Prevention and Treatment Act of 2000.
- 35 2. This section must not be construed to authorize or require the state to provide any coverage authorized by section 2 of the federal Breast and 36 Cervical Cancer Prevention and Treatment Act of 2000 before: 37 38
