AN ACT making an appropriation to The MacDonald Center for the Arts and Humanities, Inc., for the design and fabrication of exhibits for a mobile museum of ancient history and archeology that will travel to schools throughout the State of Nevada; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- **Section 1.** There is hereby appropriated from the state general fund to The MacDonald Center for the Arts and Humanities, Inc., the sum of \$100,000 for the design and fabrication of exhibits for a mobile museum of ancient history and archeology that will travel to schools throughout the State of Nevada.
- 6 **Sec. 2.** Any remaining balance of the appropriation made by section 1 of this act must not be committed for expenditure after June 30, 2003, and 8 reverts to the state general fund as soon as all payments of money committed have been made.
- 10 **Sec. 3.** This act becomes effective upon passage and approval.
