SUMMARY—Directs Legislative Commission to appoint committee to continue review of
Tahoe Regional Planning Compact. (BDR R-703)

ASSEMBLY CONCURRENT RESOLUTION—Directing the Legislative Commission to
appoint a committee to continue the review of the Tahoe Regional Planning
Compact.

- 1 WHEREAS, The Tahoe Regional Planning Compact provides for the
- 2 maintenance of the scenic, recreational, educational, scientific, natural and
- 3 public health values of the entire Lake Tahoe Basin; and
- 4 WHEREAS, The Tahoe Regional Planning Compact establishes the
- 5 Tahoe Regional Planning Agency to adopt and enforce a regional plan and
- 6 to provide opportunities for the orderly growth and development of the
- 7 Lake Tahoe Basin; and
- 8 WHEREAS, The Legislature of the State of Nevada is vitally concerned
- 9 with achieving regional goals in conserving the natural resources of the
- 10 entire Lake Tahoe Basin and with the programs and activities of the Tahoe
- 11 Regional Planning Agency that affect these goals; and
- 12 WHEREAS, As a necessary corollary to this vital concern and for the
- 13 protection of Lake Tahoe, the Legislature of the State of Nevada is also
- 14 concerned with the role and efforts of those federal and state agencies that
- 15 have authority to regulate activities in the Lake Tahoe Basin and their
- 16 interactions with and effect upon the Tahoe Regional Planning Agency and
- 17 the Lake Tahoe Basin; and
- 18 WHEREAS, Subcommittees of the Legislative Commission have
- 19 successfully reviewed the programs and activities of the Tahoe Regional
- 20 Planning Agency on previous occasions; and
- 21 WHEREAS, Senate Concurrent Resolution No. 16 of the 70th Legislative
- 22 Session directed the Legislative Commission to appoint a committee of six
- 23 legislators composed of three members of the Senate and three members of
- 24 the Assembly to continue the review of the Tahoe Regional Planning
- 25 Compact and to oversee the Tahoe Regional Planning Agency; and



1 WHEREAS, The review and oversight of the programs and activities of
2 the Tahoe Regional Planning Agency and the role of each federal and state
3 agency having authority and responsibility in the Lake Tahoe Basin
4 continue to be necessary to ensure the proper functioning of those
5 agencies; and

6 WHEREAS, It is vital to remain in communication with members of the
7 Legislature of the State of California to continue to achieve the goals set
8 forth in the Tahoe Regional Planning Compact; now, therefore, be it

9 RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY AND OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, THE
10 SENATE CONCURRING, That the Legislative Commission is hereby directed
11 to appoint a committee of six legislators composed of three members of the
12 Senate and three members of the Assembly to continue the review of the
13 Tahoe Regional Planning Compact and to oversee the Tahoe Regional
14 Planning Agency and each federal and state agency having authority to
15 regulate activities in the Lake Tahoe Basin; and be it further

16 RESOLVED, That the committee is directed to:

17 1. Review the budget, programs, activities, responsiveness and
18 accountability of the Tahoe Regional Planning Agency; and

19 2. Study the role and activities of each federal and state agency having
20 authority to regulate activities in the Lake Tahoe Basin, including, without
21 limitation, their role in the protection of Lake Tahoe and their interactions
22 with and effect upon the Tahoe Regional Planning Agency and the Lake
23 Tahoe Basin; and be it further

24 RESOLVED, That the committee is directed to communicate with
25 members of the Legislature of the State of California to achieve the goals
26 set forth in the Tahoe Regional Planning Compact; and be it further

27 RESOLVED, That the Chief Clerk of the Assembly prepare and transmit
28 a copy of this resolution to the Executive Director of the Tahoe Regional
29 Planning Agency, each member of the California delegation to the Tahoe
30 Regional Planning Agency, the President pro Tempore of the Senate of the
31 State of California and the Speaker of the Assembly of the State of
32 California.
