AN ACT relating to education; authorizing certain school districts to carry out demonstration projects in lieu of complying with the class-size reduction program; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. 1. Notwithstanding the provisions of NRS 388.700, 388.710 and 388.720 to the contrary, a school district that receives money for the 2001-2003 biennium to comply with the pupil-teacher ratios set forth in NRS 388.700, may use the money to carry out a demonstration project in which pupil-teacher ratios of 22 to 1 are established in kindergarten and grades 1 to 5, inclusive, in school years 2001-2002 and 2002-2003 to eliminate team teaching.

- 2. A school district that carries out a demonstration project authorized by subsection 1 shall:
- (a) Be deemed in compliance with the pupil-teacher ratios set forth in NRS 388.700 for the 2001-2003 biennium;
- (b) Evaluate the effectiveness of the demonstration project in improving pupil achievement; and
- 14 (c) Report its findings in an interim report to the Legislative Committee 15 on Education on or before February 15, 2002, and a final report to the 16 Director of the Legislative Counsel Bureau for transmittal to the Nevada 17 Legislature on or before February 15, 2003.
- 18 **Sec. 2.** This act becomes effective upon passage and approval.
