THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 **Section 1.** NRS 392.390 is hereby repealed.

Sec. 2. This act becomes effective upon passage and approval.

TEXT OF REPEALED SECTION

392.390 Unlawful employment of unlicensed driver; penalty. The employment of any unlicensed person to drive a vehicle when it is transporting pupils shall be unlawful. Any person violating the provisions of this section shall be guilty of a misdemeanor.
