AN ACT making an appropriation to the Nevada Test Site Historical Foundation for expenses related to the operation of the foundation; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. There is hereby appropriated from the state general fund to the Nevada Test Site Historical Foundation the sum of \$250,000 for expenses related to the operation of the foundation.

Sec. 2. Any remaining balance of the appropriation made by section 1

**Sec. 2.** Any remaining balance of the appropriation made by section 1 of this act must not be committed for expenditure after June 30, 2003, and reverts to the state general fund as soon as all payments of money committed have been made.

**Sec. 3.** This act becomes effective upon passage and approval.
