AN ACT making a contingent appropriation to the Western Folklife Center for completion of the renovation of the Pioneer Hotel Building that houses the Center; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- **Section 1.** 1. There is hereby appropriated from the state general fund to the Western Folklife Center the sum of \$300,000 to assist in the completion of the renovation to the Pioneer Hotel Building in Elko that houses the Center.
- 2. The appropriation made by subsection 1 is contingent upon the Western Folklife Center obtaining matching money from the Federal Government and \$200,000 from other sources for this project. The Western Folklife Center must submit proof satisfactory to the State Controller that the matching money from the Federal Government and from other sources has been committed before the money appropriated by subsection 1 may be distributed.
- 12 3. Any remaining balance of the appropriation made by subsection 1 must not be committed for expenditure after June 30, 2003, and reverts to 14 the state general fund as soon as all payments of money committed have 15 been made.
- 16 **Sec. 2.** This act becomes effective upon passage and approval.
