AN ACT making a contingent appropriation to the Western Folklife Center for completion of the renovation of the Pioneer Hotel Building that houses the Center; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN
SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- 1 **Section 1.** 1. There is hereby appropriated from the state general
- 2 fund to the Western Folklife Center the sum of \$300,000 to assist in the
- 3 completion of the renovation to the Pioneer Hotel Building in Elko that
- 4 houses the Center.
- 5 2. The appropriation made by subsection 1 is contingent upon the
- 6 Western Folklife Center obtaining matching money from the Federal
- 7 Government and \$200,000 from other sources for this project. The Western
- 8 Folklife Center must submit proof satisfactory to the State Controller that
- 9 the matching money from the Federal Government and from other sources
- 10 has been committed before the money appropriated by subsection 1 may be
- 11 distributed.
- 12 3. Any remaining balance of the appropriation made by subsection 1
- 13 must not be committed for expenditure after June 30, 2003, and reverts to
- 14 the state general fund as soon as all payments of money committed have
- 15 been made.
- 16 **Sec. 2.** This act becomes effective upon passage and approval.
