AN ACT relating to the department of prisons; authorizing the department of prisons to request money from the contingency fund if the offenders' store fund has insufficient money to provide for the needs of a therapeutic community; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

**Section 1.** Chapter 209 of NRS is hereby amended by adding thereto a new section to read as follows:

If the director determines that there is an insufficient amount of money in the offenders' store fund to provide for the needs of a therapeutic community, he may request an allocation from the contingency fund pursuant to NRS 353.266, 353.268 and 353.269.

Sec. 2. NRS 209.4231 is hereby amended to read as follows:

209.4231 As used in NRS 209.4231 to 209.4244, inclusive, *and* section 1 of this act, unless the context otherwise requires, the words and terms defined in NRS 209.4232 to 209.4235, inclusive, have the meanings ascribed to them in those sections.
