AN ACT relating to substances; revising the definition of the “manufacture” of a substance;  
and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN  
SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- 1     **Section 1.** NRS 453.091 is hereby amended to read as follows:  
2     453.091 1. “Manufacture” means the production, preparation,  
3     propagation, compounding, conversion or processing of a substance, either  
4     directly or indirectly by extraction from substances of natural origin, or  
5     independently by means of chemical synthesis, or by a combination of  
6     extraction and chemical synthesis, and includes any packaging or  
7     repackaging of the substance or labeling or relabeling of its container.  
8     2. “Manufacture” does not include ~~the preparation or compounding of~~  
9     ~~a substance by a person for his own use or~~ the preparation, compounding,  
10    packaging or labeling of a substance by a *pharmacist*, physician,  
11    physician’s assistant, dentist, podiatric physician, advanced practitioner of  
12    nursing or veterinarian:  
13    (a) As an incident to his administering or dispensing of a substance in  
14    the course of his professional practice; or  
15    (b) By his authorized agent under his supervision, for the purpose of, or  
16    as an incident to, research, teaching or chemical analysis and not for sale.  
17    **Sec. 2.** The amendatory provisions of this act do not apply to offenses  
18    committed before October 1, 2001.  
19    **Sec. 3.** This act becomes effective at 12:01 a.m. on October 1, 2001.
