AN ACT making an appropriation to the Aging Services Division of the Department of Human Resources for support of a program to identify and review the use of services available for Nevada's seniors; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

**Section 1.** There is hereby appropriated from the state general fund to the Aging Services Division of the Department of Human Resources the sum of \$75,000 for support of a program that will identify the services available for Nevada's seniors and determine how many seniors have made use of those services.

**Sec. 2.** Any remaining balance of the appropriation made by section 1 of this act must not be committed for expenditure after June 30, 2003, and reverts to the state general fund as soon as all payments of money committed have been made.

**Sec. 3.** This act becomes effective upon passage and approval.
