AN ACT making an appropriation to the Aging Services Division of the Department of Human Resources for support of a program to identify and review the use of services available for Nevada's seniors; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN  
SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- 1     **Section 1.** There is hereby appropriated from the state general fund to
- 2     the Aging Services Division of the Department of Human Resources the
- 3     sum of \$75,000 for support of a program that will identify the services
- 4     available for Nevada's seniors and determine how many seniors have made
- 5     use of those services.
- 6     **Sec. 2.** Any remaining balance of the appropriation made by section 1
- 7     of this act must not be committed for expenditure after June 30, 2003, and
- 8     reverts to the state general fund as soon as all payments of money
- 9     committed have been made.
- 10    **Sec. 3.** This act becomes effective upon passage and approval.
