AN ACT relating to the office of the state controller; authorizing the state controller to appoint persons to certain positions that are in the unclassified service of the state; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN  
SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- 1     **Section 1.** NRS 227.100 is hereby amended to read as follows:  
2     227.100 1. The state controller may appoint a *chief* deputy in the  
3     unclassified service of the state, who may, in the absence of the state  
4     controller, do all acts devolving upon and necessary to be performed by the  
5     state controller, except the signing of state warrants and bonds. *The state*  
6     *controller may also appoint in the unclassified service of the state:*  
7     *(a) An assistant controller;*  
8     *(b) A manager of operations for the southern region; and*  
9     *(c) An executive assistant.*  
10    2. Except as otherwise provided in NRS 284.143, *each of the* ~~deputy~~  
11    ~~state controller~~ *persons appointed pursuant to subsection 1* shall devote  
12    his entire time and attention to the business of his office and shall not  
13    pursue any other business or occupation or hold any other office of profit.  
14    **Sec. 2.** This act becomes effective on July 1, 2001.
