- **Section 1.** There is hereby appropriated from the state general fund to the Office of the Attorney General for an unanticipated shortfall caused by
- the overestimation of revenues in the budget the sum of \$500,000. This appropriation is supplemental to that made by section 4 of chapter 571,
- Statutes of Nevada 1999, at page 2978.
