AN ACT making a supplemental appropriation to the Office of the Attorney General for an unanticipated shortfall caused by the overestimation of revenues in the budget; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN
SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- 1 **Section 1.** There is hereby appropriated from the state general fund to
- 2 the Office of the Attorney General for an unanticipated shortfall caused by
- 3 the overestimation of revenues in the budget the sum of \$500,000. This
- 4 appropriation is supplemental to that made by section 4 of chapter 571,
- 5 Statutes of Nevada 1999, at page 2978.
- 6 **Sec. 2.** This act becomes effective upon passage and approval.
