AN ACT making a supplemental appropriation to the State Department of Conservation and Natural Resources for certain shortfalls in the budget; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN
SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- 1 **Section 1.** There is hereby appropriated from the state general fund to
2 the State Department of Conservation and Natural Resources the sum of
3 \$40,181 to be disbursed as follows:
4 1. For an unanticipated shortfall in the money budgeted for
5 retirement and other personnel expenses in the Director's office \$21,689
6 2. For an unanticipated shortfall in money budgeted for
7 the Division of Water Resources for expenses related to the
8 U.S.G.S. river and stream gauging, ground water measurement
9 and the the South Fork Dam monitoring programs \$18,492
10 This appropriation is supplemental to that made by section 25 of chapter
11 571, Statutes of Nevada 1999, at page 2983.
12 **Sec. 2.** This act becomes effective upon passage and approval.
