AN ACT making an appropriation to the Department of Prisons to establish a program for obtaining and storing electronic fingerprints and digital photographs for use in transferring and releasing prisoners; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

**Section 1.** There is hereby appropriated from the state general fund to the Department of Prisons the sum of \$149,750 to develop a system for obtaining and storing electronic fingerprints and digital photographs for use in transferring and releasing prisoners.

**Sec. 2.** Any remaining balance of the appropriation made by section 1 of this act must not be committed for expenditure after June 30, 2003, and reverts to the state general fund as soon as all payments of money committed have been made.

Sec. 3. This act becomes effective upon passage and approval.
