AN ACT relating to public welfare; requiring the state controller to transfer a certain amount of money from the intergovernmental transfer account in the state general fund to the fund for the institutional care of the medically indigent; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN  
SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- 1     **Section 1.** 1. The state controller shall, as soon as practicable after  
2     June 30, 2001, transfer the sum of \$500,000 from the intergovernmental  
3     transfer account in the state general fund to the fund for the institutional  
4     care of the medically indigent created by NRS 428.470.  
5     2. The money transferred pursuant to subsection 1 may be used to  
6     provide assistance to a county for a payment required by an interlocal  
7     agreement that became due during the fiscal year 2000-2001.  
8     **Sec. 2.** This act becomes effective on July 1, 2001.
