AN ACT making an appropriation to Mineral County for expenses relating to the continued renovation of the Hawthorne National Guard Armory into a facility to house juvenile offenders; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

### THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- **Section 1.** There is hereby appropriated from the state general fund to Mineral County the sum of \$179,000 for expenses relating to the continued renovation of the Hawthorne National Guard Armory into a facility to house juvenile offenders, including:
- 1. Upgrades to the heating system to allow for individual control of room temperature;
- 2. Upgrades to the gymnasium/multipurpose room to provide insulation, which would enhance the energy efficiency for heating and cooling purposes;
- 3. Enclosure of a portion of the gymnasium/multipurpose room to provide a classroom for computer training; and
- 4. Installation of a closed circuit video and audio surveillance system for security.
- **Sec. 2.** Any remaining balance of the appropriation made by section 1 of this act must not be committed for expenditure after June 30, 2003, and reverts to the state general fund as soon as all payments of money committed have been made.



1 **Sec. 3.** This act becomes effective upon passage and approval.
