AN ACT making an appropriation to the Nevada Interscholastic Activities Association for the repromulgation of their administrative regulations governing disputes; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. There is hereby appropriated from the state general fund to the Nevada Interscholastic Activities Association the sum of \$15,000 for the repromulgation of the administrative regulations of the Association that govern disputes. In repromulgating the regulations, the Association shall ensure that the new regulations afford adequate and appropriate due process protections for all parties to a dispute.

Sec. 2. Any remaining balance of the appropriation made by section 1 of this act must not be committed for expenditure after June 30, 2003, and reverts to the state general fund as soon as all payments of money committed have been made.

Sec. 3. This act becomes effective upon passage and approval.
