SUMMARY—Makes appropriations for historical facility in Virginia City and for preservation of cemeteries within Virginia City National Historic Landmark District. (BDR S-947)

AN ACT making appropriations to Storey County for a historical facility in Virginia City and to the Comstock Cemetery Foundation, Inc., for the preservation of cemeteries within the Virginia City National Historic Landmark District; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN
SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- 1 **Section 1.** 1. There is hereby appropriated from the state general
- 2 fund to Storey County the sum of \$400,000 for the construction of a
- 3 historical facility in Virginia City to be used by the county and the state.
- 4 2. The appropriation made by subsection 1 is contingent upon the
- 5 provision by Storey County of land for the proposed facility and matching
- 6 funds. The State Controller shall not transfer the sum appropriated by
- 7 subsection 1 until the Interim Finance Committee has determined that these
- 8 conditions have been satisfied.
- 9 3. Any remaining balance of the appropriation made by subsection 1
- 10 must not be committed for expenditure after June 30, 2005, and reverts to
- 11 the state general fund as soon as all payments of money committed have
- 12 been made.
- 13 **Sec. 2.** 1. There is hereby appropriated from the state general fund
- 14 to the Comstock Cemetery Foundation, Inc., the sum of \$250,000 for the
- 15 preservation of cemeteries within the Virginia City National Historic
- 16 Landmark District.



1 2. The appropriation made by subsection 1 may be used for the
2 preservation of cemeteries or to obtain matching funds to carry out this
3 purpose.

4 3. Any remaining balance of the appropriation made by subsection 1
5 must not be committed for expenditure after June 30, 2003, and reverts to
6 the state general fund as soon as all payments of money committed have
7 been made.

8 **Sec. 3.** This act becomes effective upon passage and approval.
