AN ACT making appropriations to Storey County for a historical facility in Virginia City and to the Comstock Cemetery Foundation, Inc., for the preservation of cemeteries within the Virginia City National Historic Landmark District; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

# THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. 1. There is hereby appropriated from the state general fund to Storey County the sum of \$400,000 for the construction of a historical facility in Virginia City to be used by the county and the state.
- 2. The appropriation made by subsection 1 is contingent upon the provision by Storey County of land for the proposed facility and matching funds. The State Controller shall not transfer the sum appropriated by subsection 1 until the Interim Finance Committee has determined that these conditions have been satisfied.
- 3. Any remaining balance of the appropriation made by subsection 1 must not be committed for expenditure after June 30, 2005, and reverts to the state general fund as soon as all payments of money committed have been made.
- Sec. 2. There is hereby appropriated from the state general fund to the Comstock Cemetery Foundation, Inc., the sum of \$250,000 for the preservation of cemeteries within the Virginia City National Historic Landmark District.



2. The appropriation made by subsection 1 may be used for the preservation of cemeteries or to obtain matching funds to carry out this purpose.

2 3 4 5 3. Any remaining balance of the appropriation made by subsection 1 must not be committed for expenditure after June 30, 2003, and reverts to the state general fund as soon as all payments of money committed have been made.

Sec. 3. This act becomes effective upon passage and approval.
