AN ACT making various appropriations; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN
SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- 1 **Section 1.** There is hereby appropriated from the state general fund to
2 the University and Community College System of Nevada the sum of
3 \$150,000 for the development of a curriculum necessary for students to
4 earn a bachelor's degree in human services relating primarily to substance
5 abuse counseling.
- 6 **Sec. 2.** There is hereby appropriated from the state general fund to the
7 Nevada Historical Society the sum of \$10,000 for the construction of a
8 marker on Mount Charleston that commemorates the crash of a USAF C-
9 54 aircraft in 1955.
- 10 **Sec. 3.** There is hereby appropriated from the state general fund for
11 imaging computer work stations consisting of a microscope, video
12 capturing equipment and other equipment necessary to gather evidence,
13 and evaluate and store it digitally the sum of \$290,000 to be distributed
14 equally to:
- 15 1. The crime laboratory of the Washoe County Police Department.
16 2. The crime laboratory of the Clark County Metropolitan Police
17 Department.
18 3. The Investigation Division of the Department of Motor Vehicles
19 and Public Safety.
20 4. The University and Community College System of Nevada.



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1 **Sec. 4.** There is hereby appropriated to the Clark County School
2 District the sum of \$35,000 for establishment of a program to promote
3 literacy for elementary pupils after school.

4 **Sec. 5.** Any remaining balance of the appropriations made by sections
5 1 to 4, inclusive, of this act must not be committed for expenditure after
6 June 30, 2003, and reverts to the state general fund as soon as all payments
7 of money committed have been made.

8 **Sec. 6.** This act becomes effective upon passage and approval.
